

How to vote




Use a blue or black ink pen.

State Measure Proposed Constitutional Amendment

Senate Joint Resolution No. 8201

The legislature has proposed a constitutional amendment on allowing money in Washington's long-term care fund to be invested. This amendment would allow the state fund dedicated to providing long-term benefits for eligible seniors and people with disabilities to be invested as authorized by law.

If approved, this measure would authorize Public Utility District #1 of Wahkiakum County to acquire, operate, and maintain sewer systems, in accordance with RCW 54.16.230. Voter approval is required by law for the PUD to provide sewer utility services.

Town of Cathlamet Proposition No. 1

Increase of Property Tax Levy for Retention of Basic Public Safety and Other Essential Services

The Town Council of the Town of Cathlamet adopted Resolution No. 463-25 concerning a proposition to obtain voter approval of its regular property tax levy to retain basic public safety and other essential services.

This measure would increase the regular property tax levy above the limit factor, to a rate of \$2.00 per \$1,000 assessed value for collection in 2026 and authorize the use of the 2026 levy amount as the base for computing levies in succeeding years as allowed by Chapter 84.55 RCW.
